Fisher's ATV Showdown

- Must be at least 16 years of age to participate.
- Minors (**under 18**) must have releases signed at registration.
- Classes may change depending on the number of participants.

Fisher's ATV Skills Course Rules for Participants

Participants must be of sound mind and body when entering the competition. All participants are required to sign a release form; minors must have release form signed at the registration area before registering for the event. **Unwillingness to cooperate in this situation will lead to involuntary disqualification.**

All Participants are required to wear helmets, eye protection, long pants, long-sleeve shirts, boots and gloves. Chest protector is recommended but not required.

If management believes ATV is over-sized for a rider, we reserve the right to stop that rider from participating. All ATV's must have mufflers. **Only 1 rider per ATV.**

No Alcohol prior to and/or during the qualifying or ATV Showdown.

Management has the right to adjust your class based on machine modifications. Questions regarding class selection should only be directed to management.

All ATV's must start from the designated start line. When the air-horn sounds, you can start. Times are tracked with a time clock. Time Stops when rider crosses the Finish Line.

Operate ATV at controllable speed, Ride within your skill level. All participants and ATV's must stay in the staging area during the qualifying and ATV Showdown.

The ATV and rider must stay within the event's markers. If either leaves the course, you must back up until you are back within the course boundaries before continuing forward.

If you wish to appeal a decision, it must be done before the next ATV run begins. Once the next ATV run is started, your run becomes final and cannot be appealed. **The decision of the event manager/judge is final.**

Prizes awarded. Winners/Qualifiers for Main Event will be posted at the end of each qualifier session at the ATV Skills Course Area. Winners of the Main Event will be announced from Stage on Day of Event.

Intentional unsafe riding will get you disqualified, please act in a sportsman like manner. Course is designed to be a challenge, skills can be harmful.

Management reserves the right to rework the course at anytime.

This is a timed skills course to test your riding and ATV handling skills. The object is to complete the course in the fastest time without missing any of the obstacles, moving any of the obstacle items, or knocking anything over. Obstacles may include but not limited to the following: weave in and out of flags, cones, barrels, logs and bumps, rumble over railroad ties, pulling a wagon, charge through mud, etc. After completion of the course, 1 Minute will be added to your final time for each missed obstacle item and for each obstacle item that was knocked over, moved, etc. The winner for each class will be determined by the ATV that makes it through the course in the fastest time. If no ATV makes it through the course, winner will be determined by the ATV with the farthest distance through the course. Distance will be measured by marking the front tires for the ATV where it stops.

NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN IF RIDER DECIDES NOT TO PARTICIPATE AFTER ENTRY FORM IS SUBMITTED. NO REFUND IF DISQUALIFIED.
